Courses delivered via a video conferencing tool such as TEAMS or ZOOM where you join a course on your mobile device, tablet or laptop and attend 'virtually' with other people.

7. Your login details will then be displayed on the screen. Make a note of your username (surname) and password as you will need these to log in to the Learning Zone in the future. How to log in to the Children & Families Learning Zone

- 1. You will need to do this every time you log in.
- 2. Go to the <u>Children & Families Learning Zone</u>.

- Enter the email address which you used to register on to the Learning Zone then click
 Submit Request.
- 6. You will then see confirmation that an email will be sent to you, if the email address you entered is registered in the system. If you do not receive this email you should contact your site administrator on <u>peopleandculture@nelincs.gov.uk</u> or Skillgate Customer Services on 01730 815670.
- 7. Click on **Close Window** or close the tab by clicking on the X at the top of the screen.
- 8. The email you receive will come from skillgatetutor@skillgate.com and will state that you have requested a new password for learn-nel.com. Click on the long link and follow the on-screen instructions. You will see a message confirming your password has been changed and you can now return to the <u>Children & Families Learning Zone</u> to recommence the log in process.





How to book on a workshop in the Children & Families Learning Zone

1. Click on the **Course Library icon** on the left-hand side of the screen.



2. Click on Workshops then click on a category of courses, eg. Domestic Abuse.



3. Courses in the category you have chosen will then be displayed in the centre section of the screen. Available dates will be displayed together with the start and end time and venue for the course. Click on the + sign next to the course title to see the full course description and other relevant information.




- 4. If there are still available places for this course, you will see 'Book Now' (if this is not showing it means the course is fully booked)
- 5. To book on the course, click on **Book now**.

- 6. Enter a brief statement on why you wish to attend this course.
- 7. Click on **Submit**.



- 8. You will then see the Authorisation screen confirming the details of your booking.
- 9. You can close this screen by clicking on the red **X** in the top right-hand corner.
- 10. You will see that the list of classroom courses screen no longer shows the Book Now button for this course. This is because you have already booked your place.
- 11. You will also receive a confirmation email, if your email address is held in the Learning Zone – the email will include two attachments - a brief course outline and a calendar invitation to add to your calendar.






How to cancel a workshop booking in the Children & Families Learning Zone

- 1. Click on the **Course Library icon** on the left-hand side of the screen.
- 2. Click on Workshops.
- 3. Find the course you wish to cancel in the list on the left-hand side of the screen click

on the course title.



- 4. Dates will then be displayed click on **Cancel Booking** for the relevant course.
- You will be asked if you are sure you want to cancel click **OK** and the cancellation will be processed.
- 6. You will also receive an email confirming your cancellation the email will include an attachment designed to allow you to remove the course booking from your calendar.
- Please note that cancellations can be made this way up to 7 days before the date of the course; after this period, please contact People and Culture on

How to add your name to the waiting list of a workshop in the Children & Families Learning Zone

- 1. Click on the **Course Library icon** on the left-hand side of the screen.
- 2. Click on Workshops.
- 3. Find the course you want to join the waiting list for in the category list on the left-hand side of the screen click on the course title.

4. Dates will then be displayed - click on Add to Waiting List for the relevant course.



- You will then be asked if you would like to join the waiting list and receive information about future dates as they become available – click on Yes Please.
- 6. You will then see a confirmation message that you are now on the waiting list for this course and will be advised of all future dates as they become available.
- 7. Click on Close Window.
- You will see that the list of classroom courses screen no longer shows the Add to Waiting List button for this course. This is because you are already on the waiting list – you will see this confirmed beneath the Book Now button.

 On the Safer North East Lincolnshire web page, scroll down then click on Register or Login to Online Learning - this will open the 'Enable' web page.







How to access your record of training on the Children & Families Learning Zone

- 1. Click on the My Record icon on the left-hand side of the screen.
- 2. This is where you will find evidence of course completions if you need to demonstrate this to your employer.
- 3. You will see a series of blue buttons underneath your name. These are:
 - a. Records this allows you to display a record of your training within a specified date period. When displayed, you can download this as a PDF document.
 - b. Current this displays your current course registrations.
 - c. CPD/Badges these display how many CPD (continuous professional development) points you have earned by completing courses and your achievement of bronze, silver and gold badges.
 - d. Profile this shows the personal information the system holds about you. Here you can add information on any accessibility or dietary preferences you may have.
 - e. SkillCard click on the red SkillCard icon to see a full record of your personal achievements on the Learning Zone.
 - f. Qualifications this shows details of courses you have successfully completed. From here, you will be able to access certificates of completion for any courses you have completed via the Learning Zone (see next section).
 - g. Messages this displays information on any system messages that have been sent to you.





How to access and print a certificate of completion on the Children & Families Learning Zone

- 1. Click on the My Record icon on the left-hand side of the screen.
- 2. Click on qualifications
- 3. For those courses where a certificate is available, click on the word Certificate at the end of the appropriate course title
- 4. The certificate will be displayed
- 5. To save a copy of the certificate on your computer, select Save as PDF under the Printer field on the left-hand side of the screen, then click Save. The File Explorer window will appear for you to select where you wish to file the certificate. Select the appropriate location and click Save.
- 6. To print a copy, if you have a printer connected to your device, select the appropriate printer under the Printer field on the left-hand side of the screen, then click Print.
