Our name stands for **F**riendly, **I**nclusive, **S**upportive, and **H**elpful, values that guide every aspect of our service delivery.

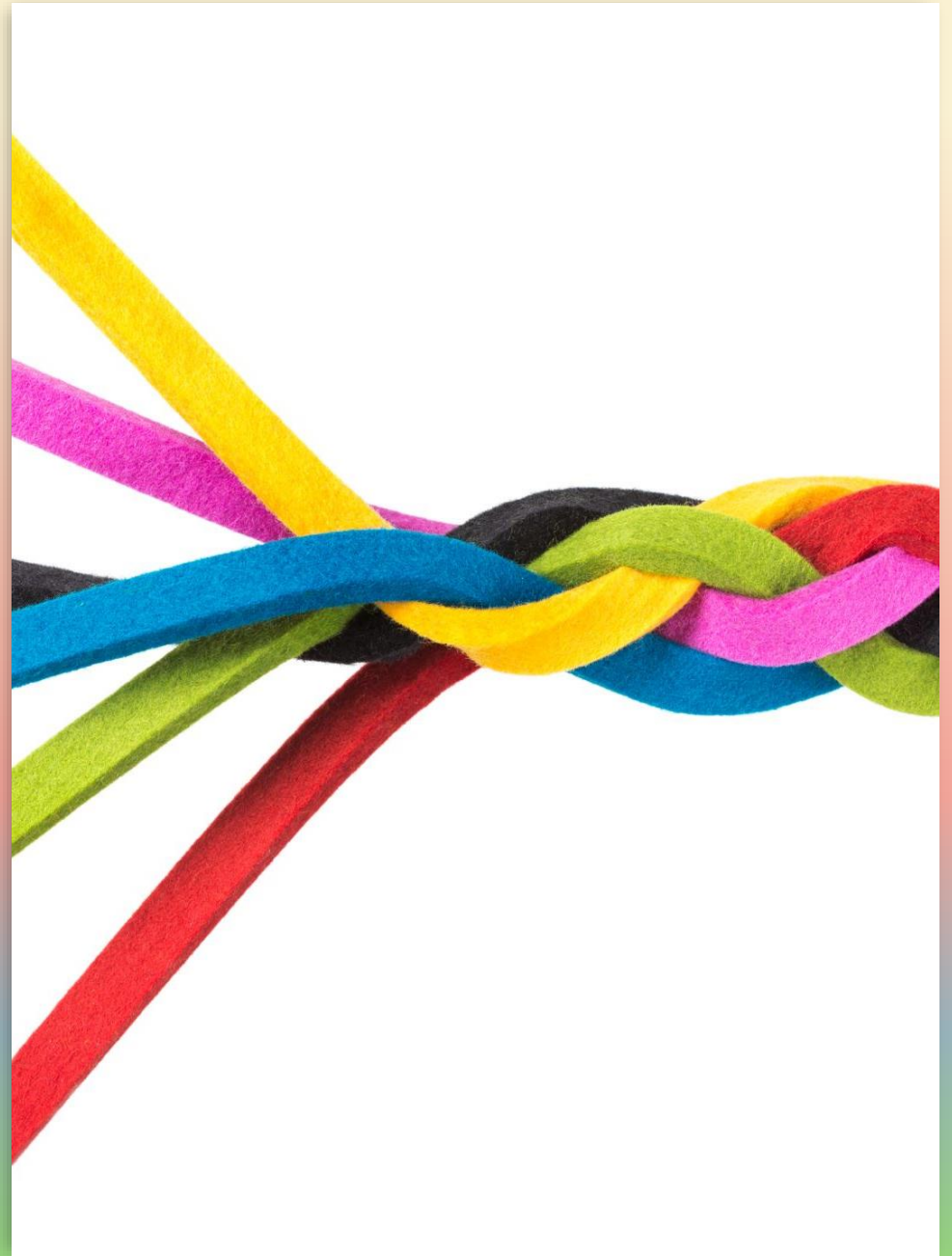
Our Services that are provided by a Community SEND support Practitioner and some of the very best volunteers.

Sussex Pavilion

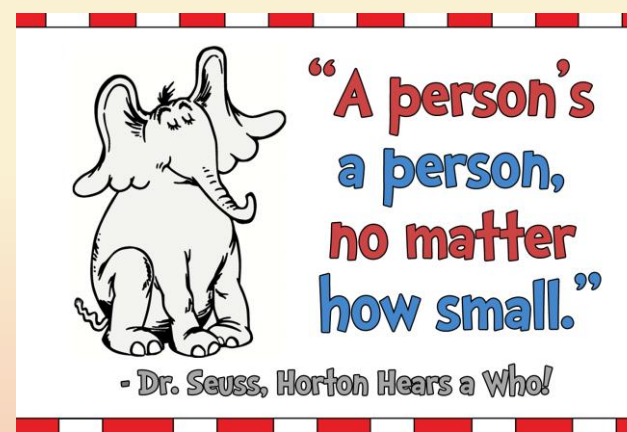

- ▶ 1. Holistic Support: - Free Assistance with EHCPs and Paperwork: Navigating the educational health care plan (EHCP) process can be overwhelming. We offer expert guidance and hands-on help with all aspects of SEND paperwork, ensuring that families receive the support they are entitled to. - Advocacy for Parents and Carers: We stand by families, providing advocacy services to ensure their voices are heard and their rights are upheld within educational and healthcare systems.
- ▶ 2. Empowerment and Training: - Empowering Families: Our goal is to empower parents and carers and their families with the knowledge and skills they need to advocate for their children confidently. We offer training sessions, workshops, and resources designed to educate and inspire. - A Voice for All: We are dedicated to giving families a platform to share their experiences and influence positive change within the community and beyond.
- ▶ 3. Inclusive Community Building: - Thriving Social Environment: We foster an inclusive community where children with S.E.N.D. and their families can thrive. Our programs and events are designed to create safe, engaging spaces for social interaction, learning, and fun. These also will create a social peer support system that will help educate and develop social bonds for children with additional needs so that in the future the impact on their lives will be greater and beneficial to themselves personally, socially and emotionally in the community. - Preventing Social Deprivation: By offering a variety of activities and support groups, we ensure that no family feels isolated. Our community events encourage participation and build connections among families facing similar challenges.

Our hope for this building is to bring in local teens and kids from varying backgrounds and of all abilities to create art of all forms.

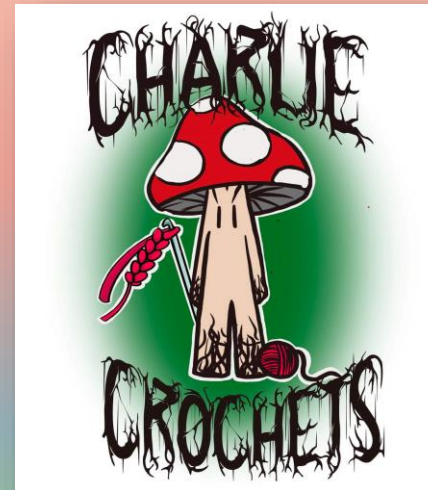
We are currently running a workshop teaching teens about selling their work and setting up small businesses doing this.
